

UVA Hosts Third Annual Girls Day Set for June 14

The University of Virginia Facilities Management Department will host girls between the ages of 10 and 16 to participate in various planned activities to increase young women's interest in and education of construction and the building trades. With more than 1,200 employees dedicated to excellence, Facilities Management is responsible for the day-to-day operation, repair and maintenance of UVA's buildings, infrastructure and grounds. The event will include behind-the-scenes tours of jobsites and an afternoon exhibitor fair with hands-on activities and games.

**WHAT:**

Approximately 80 young girls (ages 10-16) from the Charlottesville area will spend the morning touring the following work sites:
